Keeping it Low Key?

Roebling Bridge & Delaware River

The most “bang for your buck” in terms of views. Just walking over and around the bridge to admire the architecture is delightful, especially when with a coffee from nearby Stickett Inn!

Visit the Zane Grey Museum to learn about America's most famous Western novelist. Best for dogs.

Briar's Pond

A lovely walk around a pond on Masthope Mtn Community property. The map on the fridge will show you the location. Park in the mailbox parking area. No dogs allowed.

Cross Country Trails

Another walk on Masthope Mtn property. These are multiuse trails for ATVs, so take care.

Ready to Break a Sweat?

Tusten Mtn Trail (3 mi loop)

A local favorite for good reason. Tusten Mountain offers one of the most rewarding views in the Upper Delaware region. The trail passes through hardwood forest and remnants of early river life, before gradually climbing toward the ridge.

Access to Tusten Mtn Trail is across the river on the NY side near Narrowsburg. Parking is at a lovely picnic spot near a stone arch at the start of trail.

Dorflinger-Suydam Wildlife Sanctuary

Miles of interwoven trails through forest and meadows. While none are individually strenuous, you can string together a long meditative walk.
